

You Choose How Your Pledge is Used

Current Fund is used to pay for all salaries, utilities, maintenance, office supplies, operations, postage and fund all of our Ministry Programs.

Capital Fund is used for capital improvements and large maintenance expenses including, furnace replacement and parking lot improvement.

Benevolence Fund is used to support ministry work outside of our walls including support of the ELCA, St. Paul Area Synod, Tanzania and various other ministries.
