COUNCIL CONNECTION

Pastoral Transition Update

What's going on with Pastor Jim's retirement and the plan to call a new pastor?

During the time of a pastoral transition the synod office works closely with congregations. Rolf Lowenberg-DeBoer, an Assistant to the Bishop, has been assigned to work with St. Stephen throughout our transition process. He has worked with Christ the King WBL and Redeemer for their recent call processes as both have called new pastors. Rolf lives in White Bear Lake, so he has a particular interest in our community.

Rolf met with our Church Council in February and outlined the four-step transition process. Those steps are:

1) Leave taking

2) Ministry exploration at St. Stephen

3) Call process

4) Begin new chapter with new pastor

The timeframe for this entire process is typically 15-24 months. For us, that time started in January when Pastor Jim announced his plans to retire. So, we anticipate calling a new pastor sometime during 2024.

There are three main goals of the leave taking time that we are in:

Celebrate – First, we need to take the time to celebrate Jim's 30 years of service to St. Stephen. It's an incredible tenure! This is the time to eat cake, to share memories, be grateful, to laugh together and cry together, and pay attention to Jim and each other. We have a retirement celebration planned for the afternoon of Sunday, May 21. Pastor Jim's last worship service will be the evening of Wednesday, May 31, and there will be a special celebratory meal and GAP worship that night. Put those dates on your calendar and plan to be part of it.

Interim Pastor – The St. Paul Area Synod has a cadre of 22 interim pastors who are experienced and especially trained to lead congregations through interim processes. Key considerations are fit and availability. Rolf is looking to find a couple of interim pastor candidates who are available when we need them and a good fit for our needs. He plans to give us names by the end of March so that the Executive Committee can meet with them in April. We expect that by late April or early

May we should be able to announce to the congregation the name of the interim pastor who will serve St. Stephen starting on June 1.

Exit Interview — There will an exit interview in late April or early May with Pastor Jim, council members and Rolf. It will be a time of looking back and reflecting on what worked well, what challenges we faced, and envisioning what the future might look like.

We will provide regular updates throughout the pastoral transition process. If you have questions or suggestions, talk with council members about it. Also, please pray that God is at work as we walk together through this time of transition, guiding us and caring for us each step along the way, leading us into hopeful future God has planned for St. Stephen.

Council Highlights

Synod delegates were selected to represent St. Stephen at St. Paul Area Synod Assembly May 12-13: Denise Ashley and Scott Zieman along with Pastor Jim and Pastor Juli.

The "Evergreen Team" that had been appointed by the council is investigating ways to close the gap between income and expenses in a sustainable way. This team is working in tandem with the Finance Committee and Stewardship Committee. Some team members reported on initial brainstormed ideas. If you have suggestions, contact team members: Ted Field, Patsy Olson, Ken Smith, Kathy Stickler, Randy Amborn, Marla Amborn or Pastor Jim.

We received an update on the pastoral transition process. We should have names for possible interim pastor candidates by the end of March.

The council reviewed transcribed items from the February 18 Visioning Retreat. Results will be used as part of the pastoral transition process, especially during the Ministry Exploration phase that will start in June.

John Rohr regrettably resigned his council position due to health issues. The Nominating Committee will be asked to identify someone to complete the remaining time of John's term of service (the rest of 2023 and 2024).


