



CHURCH MATTERS

Church Council Highlights

At the church council meeting on November 11th, the following matters were addressed:

A first draft of a 2025 church budget was presented by Treasurer Mary Beth Skunes and discussed by council members. The budget, which will be finalized at next month's council meeting and brought to the annual congregational meeting in January for final approval, is approximately 10% higher than 2024's budget, with two notable reasons to cite. One is a full year will a full-time lead pastor. Another is the monthly premium and interest payment for the parking lot replacement.



- ♦ Cheryl Skrypez and Ron Johnson, members of the nominating committee, reported the names of three new council members for the congregation to approve at January's annual meeting.
- Kathy Stickler led a discussion about the council's appearance at the Trunk-or-Treat event at South Campus last month, which was heavily attended by parents, children and youth in the community. Our pastors and several members also decorated cars and participated. We discussed that next year St. Stephen's participation in the event would be heightened with greater notice if we parked our vehicles together in a campus-like cluster.




Volunteer **Opportunity** To Be Church




