




Join Us at Marketfest! (7/10 & 7/17)

Relay for Life is one way the American Cancer Society collects donations to support cancer research and cancer care. Our team, the Spirit of St. Stephen, is celebrating its 30th year supporting this important ministry for our church and a worthy outreach activity for our community. And to add to the fun, this is the 40th anniversary of the very first Relay for Life, with the theme, "There's No Place Like Hope".

Last year, we made some changes to how we organize as a church. We liked those changes, so we will continue to implement them:

- Viki Bosin registered the team and will be the team captain.
- ◆ To participate on the team, go to wbrelay.org, (sign in if you have been a member in the past), and click on 'Join this Relay'. You will be asked a few simple questions, including your t-shirt size. Once you raise \$100 or more, you will join the Hope Club and receive a Hope Club t-shirt by mail before the event. Make sure to indicate it if you are also a Survivor.
- Team members can fundraise outside of

- church like they often do. See Viki Bosin for materials, information and ideas.
- Cancer survivors who would like to walk in the Survivor Lap need to register online before the event (soon!) to



- receive their t-shirt. You can also register at the event, but they won't have this year's official t-shirts, but you can wear a Survivor shirt from a previous year. All survivors also receive a goody bag and lots of support.
- Dave and Viki Bosin are sponsoring the team. We usually have 10-12 other sponsors. Viki will have those forms at church services beginning June 15, if you would like to sponsor the team. (A sponsorship is \$150 or more).
- Viki will also collect any donations to the Relay. We can accept cash, or checks made out to American Cancer Society, and Viki will be able to accept electronic donations.



- Luminaries We will begin selling luminaries June 29, but with some changes. When you purchase luminaries, you will take them with you to write the names and decorate yourself. Then you bring them back on Luminary Sunday (July 20) or Wednesday (July 23) and place them on the altar/stage yourself. After the service, you are encouraged to take them home with you. On Friday evening, you can bring them to the Relay for Life at North Campus and place them on the track yourself, or you can set them up at your home that evening to honor your loved ones. With each luminary, you make a \$10 donation to the American Cancer Society.

Nordic Walking Ends (8/26)



Crafts Needed for the Holly Boutique


Please remember the Holly Boutique will be November 8 and it's not too early to start making items to be sold. We are accepting hand-made crafts and hope you would consider donating for our sale.
