# **ELCA Bishop-Elect: The Rev. Yehiel Curry**

The Rev. Yehiel Curry (pictured right) has been elected to a six-year term as presiding bishop of the ELCA. The election took place July 30 during the ELCA Churchwide Assembly in Phoenix, Ariz. Curry, who was elected on the fifth ballot, will be the ELCA's first Black presiding bishop.

# **New Automated External Defibrillator (AED)**

We have a new AED located in the mounted case just outside the sanctuary doors. This is a lightweight, portable device that delivers an electric shock through the chest to the heart when it detects an abnormal rhythm and changes the rhythm back to normal. The AED is in its own case that when opened, automatically begins giving voice instructions and visual prompts.

# **Sharps Containers Located in Restrooms**

Sharps containers are now located in our restrooms. They are specifically designed to safely collect and dispose of medical needles, syringes, and other sharp objects.


