#### **CHURCH MATTERS**

### **Church Council Highlights**

At the church council meeting on November 10<sup>th</sup>, the following matters were addressed:

- 1. A "preliminary" draft of the 2026 budget was presented for discussion. Council members were given 10 days to fine-tune budget figures for various items related to individual ministry team budgets. At the Council's December meeting the revised draft will be presented, with perhaps last minute adjustments made before being brought to the annual congregational meeting in January for final approval.
- 2. The November treasurer's report was presented, showing we are carrying a \$20,000 general fund deficit. The forecast is that we will face an income challenge in the next two months, with \$85,000 in revenue needed between now and the end of the year to avoid a year-end deficit.
- 3. The shared Wednesday GAP service with Redeemer was discussed. The service is switching to a dinner-church model this week, and during Advent the service will move to Redeemer where it will be held until Easter.
- 4. Required amendments to our constitution were presented and approved. The next step is Synod approval, after which they will be shared with the congregation before being brought to the January congregational meeting for approval.



### Communion Assistant Training (1/11/26)


